In recent years, Minimal Intervention Dentistry (MID) has gained a great deal of interest in the field of paediatric dentistry. In this workshop organised by the DentAlliance, you will learn techniques on how to facilitate a child's preventive visit to the dentist at one year old. Moreover, an introduction to oral care techniques such as the application of Silver Diamine Fluoride (SDF) and the placement of stainless steel crowns to manage caries in young children without the use of local anaesthesia will be elaborated. When local anaesthesia is required, our trainers will demonstrate the use of computer-assisted delivery such as the STA Wand machine and share tips on behaviour management strategies to minimise pain for anxious children and adult patients.

Through this hands-on workshop, participants will learn about:



- Managing Infant Oral Health: Preparing for the Dental Visit at 1 Year Old
- Silver Diamine Fluoride: Indications and Procedures
- Hall Technique Crown: Indications and Procedures
- Painless Local Anaesthesia Techniques (Computerassisted Local Anaesthesia Delivery)

Participants are required to bring <u>two</u> adult or kid's extracted teeth (carious).
