- It is a compulsory module for graduation. The grading is “Completed (Satisfactory)”/“Completed (Unsatisfactory)” on the basis of student presentation, participation and presentation.
- Students are advised to follow the guideline closely in attaining the number of sessions required. If students are unable to attain the number of sessions in the first year (for MSc candidates) or the first two years (for PhD candidates) of candidature, please discuss with your supervisor on how you could make it up in the following final year of candidature.
