Message from

the Dean

The Faculty has enjoyed and is deeply appreciative of the continuing support of its alumni especially in guiding and grooming the next generation of dental professionals. Our alumni's profile, prominence and achievements play an important part in maintaining the local and international reputation of the Faculty, both in clinical professionalism and contribution to community.

Our alumni shone in their contributions towards the Faculty's activities this past year. In partnership with the Guild of Dental Graduates, the faculty launched the Alumni Mentorship Scheme in July 2006 and we rapidly achieved the needed number of volunteer alumni mentors. Each volunteer alumnus mentors 2 undergraduate dental students for 2 year stints. Each undergraduate student would thus have experienced the advise and counsel of 2 alumni during his or her undergraduate course. Feedback on the scheme from both mentors and mentees has been positive and most encouraging. With alumni serving as role models, we firmly believe that the Dental Profession, as a whole, will be strengthened through this stronger practitioner – student links.

We also received heartening support towards our Student Bursary Awards for Dentistry. With the increasing number of students requiring financial support, 12 more alumni answered the call and came "The faculty continues to forge ahead with its research mission. forward to contribute towards the Fund, making a total of 16 pledged bursary awards for our needy students.

In July 2007, an enhanced Adjunct Staff Scheme replaced the part-time teachers scheme for private practitioners. Adjunct staff titles for our large crop of teachers from the private sector now allows the faculty to more appropriately recognise these dedicated clinicians who regularly participate and contribute towards teaching in both undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

Expansion in continuing dental education programmes continues to be spearheaded by the Centre for Advanced Dental Education (CADE). The faculty will expand the intake of MDS programmes in response to increased demand from quality applicants throughout the region. In AY 2006, the MDS Orthodontics residency programme doubled its intake. The first Graduate Diploma programme was launched with the Graduate Diploma in Dental Implantology taking in its first intake in January 2007.

Building on key research strengths, the Faculty established 3 research units - the Centre for Cranio-facial and Regenerative Biology (CCRB), the Dental Biophotonics Programme (DBBP) and the Cranio-facial Clinical Research Unit (CCRU) to improve oral health and delivery of clinical care.

The faculty continues to forge ahead with its research mission. External recognition of the quality of research is evident in the research prizes and awards won at the national and international level. Some highlights are:

• A UROP group comprising three Year 4 students won one of the inaugural Outstanding Undergraduate Researcher (OUR) Group Prizes, awarded by the university.

- A PhD student in Cariology research in the Department of Preventive Dentistry was the recipient of the prestigious International Association for Dental Research (IADR) Lion Dental Research Award for Junior Investigators in Behavioral Sciences & Health Services Research. The award was presented at the IADR General Session in New Orleans in March 2007.
- The partnership with Rapid Tech Pte Ltd for In-vitro and In-vivo Testing of Bio-scaffold for Bone Re-construction and Implants has matured from basic science research to collaboration in clinical trials.

Continuing education activities for the profession continues to ramp up through our Centre for Advanced Dental Education (CADE). A successful 2nd Faculty of Dentistry Symposium in January 2007 featured renowned overseas speakers Professor Steven Morgano and Professor Maurizio Tonetti. Together with the Singapore Dental Association, we co-hosted the 7th NUS-SDA Distinguished Speaker program in April 2007 with Professor Monty Duggal of Leeds Dental Institute providing a well received update in Pediatric Dentistry.

The faculty continues to spread its wings globally with the signing of a MOU with the renowned School of Stomatology, Beijing University (BJU). Collaborations in areas of academic exchange and research were agreed upon and exchange of visits by staff of both NUS and BJU over the past few years have led to this formal link. The first group of 6 undergraduate students visited BJU in September 2006 on exchange. Research projects in areas of 3D imaging and visualization of craniofacial region, stem cells and tissue engineering/tissue regeneration, special interests in salivary gland disease management and distraction osteogenesis are ongoing.

Academic Year 2006/07 saw the first increase in the BDS class size in several decades, going from 34 to 42. This increase, together with expansion in postgraduate residency programmes and Graduate Diploma courses will mean that our current clinical and teaching facilities will be fully utilized. Whilst we work towards optimizing space usage at our current site in the next few years, we also look forward to the possibility of major infrastructure developments at the Kent Ridge Campus - NUH site with the increasing national focus and resources available for Translational Clinical Research. Possible expansion plans that may involve a new building for the Faculty are on the horizon and we look forward toward this exciting prospect as we strive to achieve our Vision and our Mission for the improvement of oral health through academic excellence, high impact research and quality clinical service.

FACULTY'S STRATEGIC PLANS An Update

Faculty had identified its main strategic priorities:

Research

Building on key research strengths, the Faculty's research focus was channeled through these 3 centres/units: Centre for Craniofacial and Regenerative Biology (CCRB), Dental Biophotonics and Biomaterials Programme (DBBP) and Craniofacial Clinical Research Unit (CCRU).



Graduate Residency Training Programmes

In support of the Faculty's objective to be a regional centre for clinical specialty training, the Faculty had increased its intake of residents for its full time programme starting with MDS (Orthodontics) programme. The intake was increased from 3 to 6 residents from AY2006.

Centre for Advanced Dental Education

To raise the profile of dental education, the newly established Centre for Advanced Dental Education (CADE) conducted its inaugural 2-year part time course leading to the Graduate Diploma in Dental Implantology (GDDI). This inaugural year saw two intakes of 6 students each. Subsequently, there will be only one batch of intake per academic year.

First Intake of GDDI Students

The Centre for Advanced Dental Education (CADE) is one of the Faculty's new strategic initiatives. Established in July 2006, CADE is headed by Professor Chew Chong Lin as Director. Its aim is to provide dental professionals with quality continuing education through courses and programmes.



The Graduate Diploma in Dental Implantology is the first graduate diploma programme offered by the centre. This programme is timely as there is a demand for training in the area of dental implants due to an increase in awareness. Students will be equipped with the knowledge and skill to provide surgical and restorative treatment in implant dentistry. The 2-year part-time programme commenced in January 2007 and six students were accepted for the first intake.

NUS-SDA Distinguished Speaker Programme - Prof Monty Duggal



The NUS-SDA Distinguished Speaker Programme is a joint project of NUS and Singapore Dental Association (SDA) to engage internationally renowned and outstanding clinicians to conduct education programmes for the dental profession.

This year saw Professor Monty Duggal from Leeds Dental Institute as the 7th Distinguished Speaker. Professor Duggal is the head of the Division of Paediatric Dentistry at Leeds. The theme of his lecture was "Pediatric Dentistry in the New Millennium: Providing Children with the Quality Dental Care they Deserve".

- b) Prevention and Treatment of Childhood Caries
- c) Update of Pulp Therapy in Children
- d) Management of Dental Trauma in Children


Student Achievements



Major renovations were made to the General Practice Unit (GPU) this academic year. GPU underwent renovations to increase the number of dental clinical units and operatory rooms.








