



Overall task.

A Bunch of Important Final Notes.

A. Dress Code.

- Stick to the reporting attires/clothes set in 4. Packing List.
- When in NUCOHS or when attire is listed as "formal attire", please follow the guidelines on the dress code:
 - T-shirt and jeans or long pants.

 - Preferably no skirts/dresses for girls because we will be playing a lot of games!
