GUIDELINES FOR ATTACHMENT STUDENTS

About the programme

1. The period of attachment is up to a maximum of 3 weeks, unless otherwise specified.
2. Attachment is subject to Programme Director's approval and receipt of full payment of attachment fees upon confirmation of applicant's acceptance. Faculty will not be able to entertain requests during the Examination (in May) period and during term vacations. Dean's Office will inform applicant if request is successful.
3. There will be NO HANDS ON EXPERIENCE in the clinics. Successful applicants will only be allowed to observe. Attachment will only be conducted in the premises of the National University of Singapore and teaching clinics located at National University Hospital.
4. This is a voluntary programme and there will be no remuneration paid for the duration of attachment.

Guidelines for participants

All participants of the Clinical Attachment Programme must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. There will be NO HANDS ON EXPERIENCE in the clinics of the National University Hospital. While attached to the clinics, participants -
 - a. are not allowed to enter patient areas unsupervised.
 - b. must remain as silent observers in the presence of patients/patients' relatives.
 - c. must take leave if they recognize a patient.
 - d. must maintain full confidentiality regarding the patient(s) in National University Hospital.
2. Participants must have valid medical health insurance coverage during their period of attachment. Certificate (or certified true-copy) must be produced for our verification upon arrival.
3. The National University of Singapore and/or the National University Hospital will not be held responsible for any mishaps or loss of personal belongings during the period of attachment.
4. Participants must adhere to the Faculty of Dentistry's Dress Code while on campus.

Dress/Skirts:	Dresses and skirts should be of decent length.
Tops:	Male - Long/short sleeved shirts with collars. No T-shirts. Female- No T-shirts, skimpy tops e.g. tubes, halter necks, toga tops, spaghetti straps or short blouses e.g. crop tops.
Bottoms:	No jeans, shorts or bermudas.
Name Tags/ I.D	ID tags are to be worn at all times for identification purposes.
Shoes:	For safety reasons, covered shoes are to be worn during clinical sessions. Open toed sandals, slippers or backless shoes without straps are not permitted.
Jewellery:	Any jewellery worn must be simple and not interfere with work. All jewellery must comply with principles of asepsis and not cause injury to patients.
Hair:	Hair must be clean, well groomed, neatly arranged and secured to prevent it from falling into the sterile/ working field. Male students must keep beards and moustaches clean and neatly trimmed or be clean-shaven.

5. Confidential information which may have been acquired during the course of attachment with the University shall not, during or after the termination of attachment, be used or disclosed to any third party.
