

Master of Dental Surgery Residency Training Programme Admission Fact Sheet

About the Programme

This is a 3-year full-time structured didactic and clinical training programme and is offered in 6 specialties. The course commences in July.

Entry Requirements

For admission as a candidate to the course leading to the degree of Master of Dental Surgery, candidate must –

- Hold a basic dental degree qualification (Bachelor of Dental Surgery or equivalent);
- Have at least two years full-time clinical experience in general dentistry after graduation (excluding internship);
- Complete the TOEFL or IELTS if the native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English. The minimum acceptable scores are: TOEFL score – 580 (paper-based), 237 (computer-based), 92 (internet-based) & above or IELTS – 7. Test scores for the TOEFL and IELTS are valid for 2 years from the test date;
- For application to the MDS (**Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery**) Programme, refer to the details below:

For MDS(OMS) applicants, you will only be considered for the Selection Interviews if you :

(i) have either of the following qualifications :

- Part 1 MDS Exam or its equivalent
- Medical degree

OR

(ii) have passed the MDS (OMS) Selection Test which tests the applicant's knowledge on basic medical sciences, including, anatomy, dental anatomy, physiology, microbiology and pathology.

Registration for the MDS(OMS) Selection Test

Please note that :

(i) Only those who meet the MDS(OMS) Entry Requirements should register for the OMS Selection Test. The entry requirements are as follows :

- Hold a basic dental degree qualification (Bachelor of Dental Surgery or equivalent);
- Have at least two years full-time clinical experience in general dentistry after graduation (excluding internship);
- Complete the TOEFL or IELTS if the native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English. The minimum acceptable scores are: TOEFL score – 580 (paper-based), 237 (computer-based), 92 (internet-based) & above or IELTS – 7.

- (ii) Graduate Office reserves the right to allow only those who have met the MDS(OMS) entry requirements to sit for the MDS(OMS) Selection Test
- (iii) Closing Date for Registration is **15 October 2023**;
- (iv) The selection test will be conducted on **31 October 2023**. The test result will not be released to Candidates;

Health Requirements

In accordance with the Ministry of Health requirements, admission to Dentistry is subject to the following virus screening and immunization:-

- 1) Hepatitis B Virus (HBV) – All prospective students must be tested HBsAg negative. Those who are tested negative but are not immune are required to be immunized so as to prevent HBV transmission in healthcare workplace. All immunizations must begin within one month from the date of screening.
- 2) Varicella Zoster Virus (Chickenpox) - All prospective students must undergo screening for immunity to the Varicella Zoster Virus (VZV). Those tested negative for VZV immunity will be required to be immunized within one month from the date of screening.
- 3) Rubella Virus - All prospective students must undergo screening for immunity to the Rubella Virus. Those tested negative for Rubella immunity will be required to be immunized within one month from the date of screening.

NUS reserves the right to retest any or all of its new dental residents for any or all markers of Hepatitis B virus, and exclude any candidate tested positive for HBV from the Dentistry course.

Students need to show proof of medical fitness and produce documentary evidence of HIV Negative, Hepatitis B and C, Varicella Zoster Virus (Chickenpox) and Mumps, Measles and Rubella (MMR) immune status.

Paediatric Dentistry residents need to show vaccination of boostrix if they are handling paediatric/neonates patients.

On-line Application	<p>All applications should be submitted on-line at https://inetapps.nus.edu.sg/GDA2/Home.aspx</p> <p>Shortlisted candidates will be required to attend an interview in February/March. Attendance in person is compulsory for acceptance into the course. Candidates for selected specialties may also be required to take pre-admission written and/or manual dexterity tests.</p>

The financial statement should indicate a total of at least S\$15,000 per year for living expenses, in addition to the tuition and miscellaneous student fees for the duration of the Programme.</p>

Degree Requirements	<p>Candidates who have been admitted to the clinical residency training programme will be conferred the Degree of Master of Dental Surgery upon fulfillment of the following requirements –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • complete the three-year residency training programme in any one of the specialised disciplines; • pass Final MDS Examination in any one of the specialised disciplines • undertake a research project and publish a dissertation as a partial fulfilment for the award of Master of Dental Surgery degree. • Dentists who are on Full Registration (F-reg) and Conditional Registration (C-reg) are required to fulfil 70 CPE points for each 2-year qualifying period (QP). Dentists who are on Temporary Registration (T-reg) are required to fulfil 20 CPE points per year.
