Through this 2-day workshop, participants will be able to:

1. appreciate the various techniques of root canal obturation;
2. apply the use of obturation material and equipment in a safe and efficient manners;
3. appreciate the various principles of direct and indirect foundation restorations;
4. have sufficient understanding of restorative spiral, and the need for conservative dentistry;
5. familiarise with the indications and contra-indications of the various direct and indirect foundation restorations;
6. prepare, and assess quality of fit of foundation restorations;
7. familiarise with the indication and contra-indication of the various extra-coronal restorations for cuspal protection and
8. prepare, and provisionalise the different types of cuspal protection restorations.

2. Participants are encouraged to bring 3 or more extracted teeth with access cavity.

Foundation Restorations – Pillars to Success

To post or not to post. That is the question.

Plagued with the myriad of choices of foundation restorations available in the market? Fibre-reinforced dual taper post? Cylindro-conical fibre post? Parallel sided vented metal post? Cast post core choice of alloy? 2-piece cast post core?

We are here to help decipher, debunk, demystify the key pillars to successful foundation restorations.

Part III:

Cuspal Coverage – there's more to it than crown!

Crowning an endodontically treated tooth, while providing the protection it needs, it pushes a tooth further down the restorative spiral. It doesn't have to be!

Onlay can be a good and conservative alternative, meeting functional and protective demands of the cuspal coverage. This session will be a great opportunity to gain tips on effective abutment designs for lasting restorations.
