Dr Tan Hee Hon

Assistant Dean (Clinical Education), NUS Faculty of Dentistry | Senior Consultant, NUCOHS

Dr Tan Hee Hon is a specialist prosthodontist with over three decades of clinical and academic experience. His expertise in orofacial pain was developed through a dedicated sabbatical at the Oral Medicine Department, School of Dentistry, University of Washington, after which he established and led the Orofacial Pain Management Programme at the National Dental Centre. Since joining NUS Faculty of Dentistry in 2014, he has been teaching both Prosthodontics and Orofacial Pain, bringing a wealth of clinical insight to the management of Temporomandibular Disorders. In this workshop, Dr Tan will draw on his extensive experience in clinical education and patient-centred care.



Professor Chris Peck

Dean, NUS Faculty of Dentistry | Senior Consultant, NUCOHS

Professor Chris Peck is an internationally recognised clinical pain researcher whose work bridges fundamental science and clinical practice. Over the past two decades, he has co-developed models explaining the impact of pain on normal function, contributed to understanding mechanisms underlying persistent oral and facial pain, and helped establish a standardised international classification of orofacial pain. He leads interdisciplinary clinical teams to help patients manage complex pain conditions. In this workshop, Prof Peck will provide participants with a contemporary, evidence-based framework for understanding and managing TMD.



Dr Eunice Lua

Academic Fellow, NUS Faculty of Dentistry | Associate Consultant, NUCOHS

Dr Eunice Lua is an early-career clinician-academic with a focused interest in orofacial pain and implant prosthodontics. Currently pursuing her PhD at NUS Faculty of Dentistry, she combines active clinical practice as a Associate Consultant in the Division of Prosthodontics at the National University Centre For Oral Health Singapore (NUCOHS) with a growing research portfolio. Her work has been recognised internationally with the IADR Samuel F Dworkin Predoctoral Award, one of the field's most prestigious early-career honours. In this workshop, Dr Lua will contribute her up-to-date knowledge of current research and clinical approaches to TMD management.
